

Simple Shawl

One skein of your favorite sock yarn

Size 4 circular needle at least 24" long



CO 3

KFB inc in first st, pm, K, pm, KFB inc

Row 2 KFB in first stitch, K to marker, sm, k, sm, k until 1 st remains, KFB

Row 3: KFB, K to marker, yo, sm, k, sm, yo, k until 1 st remains, KFB

Row 4: KFB in first stitch, K to marker, sm, k, sm, k until 1 st remains, KFB

Repeat rows 3 and 4 two times

Row 9: KFB, (yo K2tog) repeat until marker yo, sm, k, sm, (yo K2tog) repeat until 1 st remains, yo, KFB

Row 10: KFB in first stitch, K to marker, sm, k, sm, k until 1 st remains, KFB

Repeat Rows 3 – 10 until you run low on yarn.

Bind off.

Abbreviations:

K = knit

KFB = knit front and back increase

Pm = place marker

Sm = slip marker

Yo = Yarn over

My Trick: Used two different markers. So when the blue one was first, then I knew it was an odd row and I needed to do the YO before and after the center stitch.
